Beaumont Veterinary Group's history is something we are all very proud of. Established in 1964 in Beaumont Street after which it was named, the practice later moved to Botley Road and in the mid 70's became one of the first veterinary hospitals in the country, specialising in the care of pet animals.

We now have three sites located in Botley, Kidlington and Headington respectively. Beaumont is staffed by a great team of hard-working and dedicated veterinary professionals, each bringing their own particular skills and interests to the practice. All our practices are 100% small animal, primarily treating dogs, cats, rabbits, guinea pigs and other exotic animals. Each site is equipped with laboratory, x-ray and surgical facilities. We also offer ultrasonography, echocardiography, ECG and endoscopy at our Botley Road branch.

We cater our service to clients' individual needs and offer same day or latest next day home visits to clients with our ambulance, should they require this service. Clients who require discrete care (celebrities, kennels for 'dangerous' dogs, police kennels etc.) are visited by private vehicle so as to not attract any attention. Discrete care is also offered over lunch periods (when likelihood of other clients are low) at any of our facilities.

We also have sound experience in dealing with aggressive or 'dangerous' animals, working dogs (police sniffer dogs, dogs for the disabled etc) and count many charities, rescue centres and police departments as our clients.

We promise discretion where needed to all these clients and even adjust our accounting and paperwork to protect the location and identity of such facilities.

As part of our service we offer vaccination, neutering, tattooing and micro-chipping off site to these facilities.

Destruction orders are dealt with as soon as possible with a guaranteed response time of 48hrs.

Our vets frequently incorporate complementary services such as acupuncture, homeopathy, essential oil therapy, hydrotherapy and behavioural therapy as part of their treatment regimes by means of referral.

As an RCVS tier II standard training practice for Veterinary nurses, we ensure our trainees receive the highest levels of practical and theoretical instruction on and off site.

Our team of enthusiastic nurses offer a variety of FREE preventative health clinics providing advice on the most up to date information on pet care and are just a phone call away to answer any questions you may have.
